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#### **Student Director**

(M-F 3:15-6pm, Sat 9am-1pm)

- Larger commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Responsible for cast attendance, line rehearsal
- Works with the stage manager to stay aware of what is happening with tech
- Prepares the theater for rehearsals and cleans up after
- Calls the show from the booth during performances
- Prior experience in theater preferred

#### Stage Manager

(M, T, Th 7-9pm, Sat 9am-3pm)

- Larger commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Mandatory 3 days/week of set construction crew
- Manage the stage crew and work with other crew heads
- Must attend some acting rehearsals to become familiar with the show
- Prior experience in theater preferred
- Above also applies to the Assistant Stage Manager

#### **Props Master**

(M, T, Th 7-9pm, Sat 9am-3pm)

- Larger commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Mandatory 2 days/week of set construction crew
- Assist in building or acquiring the props for the production
- Organize the props during, before and after each production
- Must attend some acting rehearsals to become familiar with the show
- Prior experience in theater preferred

#### **Set Crew Heads**

(M, T, Th 7-9pm, Sat 9am-3pm)

- Larger commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Mandatory 3 days/week of set construction crew
- The set crews heads know what projects are currently being worked on and help George assign tasks to students
- Assist students in checking in at the beginning/end of set
- At least 1 set crew head is expected to be at every set construction session and they will work with each other to develop a schedule

## Set/Props Construction (M, T, Th 7-9pm, Sat 9am-3pm)

- Light commitment, minimum of 10 hours
- No need to be an artist to participate, we will teach you
- Help build and paint the sets and props for the show
- Flexible hours, come when you can

#### Running Crew

(Final Week, All Performances)

- Light commitment, minimum of 20 hours of set construction
- Must attend all dress rehearsals and performances
- Responsible for moving set, props, curtains, etc. during the performances

#### Costume Crew

(M, T, Th 6:30-8:30pm, Sat 9-12pm)

- Light commitment, minimum of 10 hours
- Build or pull the costumes for the production
- Assist with the costume parade, including helping actors find their costumes
- Organize the costumes prior to dress rehearsal week
- No sewing experience required
- Flexible hours, come when you can
- Need everyone this Saturday and next week for measurements

#### Make-Up Crew

(Final Week, All Performances)

- Light commitment, minimum of 20 hours of costume crew
- Must attend all dress rehearsals and performances
- Responsible for assisting actors in the application of their make-up
- May be asked to assist actors with costumes or quick changes as well

#### Lighting Crew

(W 6-7:30pm, increasing in the last 3 weeks)

- Medium commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Currently Scheduled Meetings:
  - Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 6-7pm
  - Check the online calendar for additional dates
- Assists in designing and programing the lights for the production
- Hangs the lighting plot before the show opens
- Runs the lighting board or spotlights during performances
- Prior lighting experience preferred

#### Sound Crew

(W 7:30-9pm, increasing in the last 3 weeks)

- Medium commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Currently Scheduled Meetings:
  - Wednesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> from 7-9pm
  - Check the online calendar for additional dates
- Designs the sound for the show
- Prepares the sound equipment for tech Saturday
- Runs the sound board during performances
- Prior sound experience preferred

#### Video Crew

(Th 6-7pm, increasing in the last 3 weeks)

- Medium commitment, including some mandatory dates
- Currently Scheduled Meetings:
  - Thursday, September 25<sup>th</sup> from 6-7pm
  - Check the online calendar for additional dates
- Produce promotional videos for the production
- Record all the productions for the end of the year highlight reel
- Produce a highlight reel of the show for the theater banquet in the spring

# Spotlight Tech Awards

Students who worked as the lead, assistant or as a part of a team in a creative, technical or business area of their school's production are eligible for a SpotLight Behind-the-Scenes Award as an Honorable Mention or Outstanding candidate in their respective categories and areas of nomination.

- Creative Achievement: This category seeks to honor students who were a part of the creative artistic team for their production
- Technical Achievement: This category seeks to honor students who were a part of the technical execution of their production.
- Business of the Arts Achievement: This category seeks to honor students who served in a business of the arts capacity for their production.
