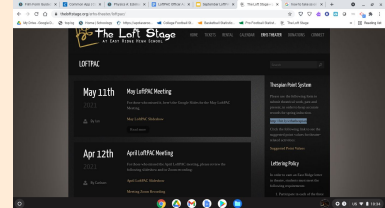
# WHAT ARE THESPIAN POINTS?
