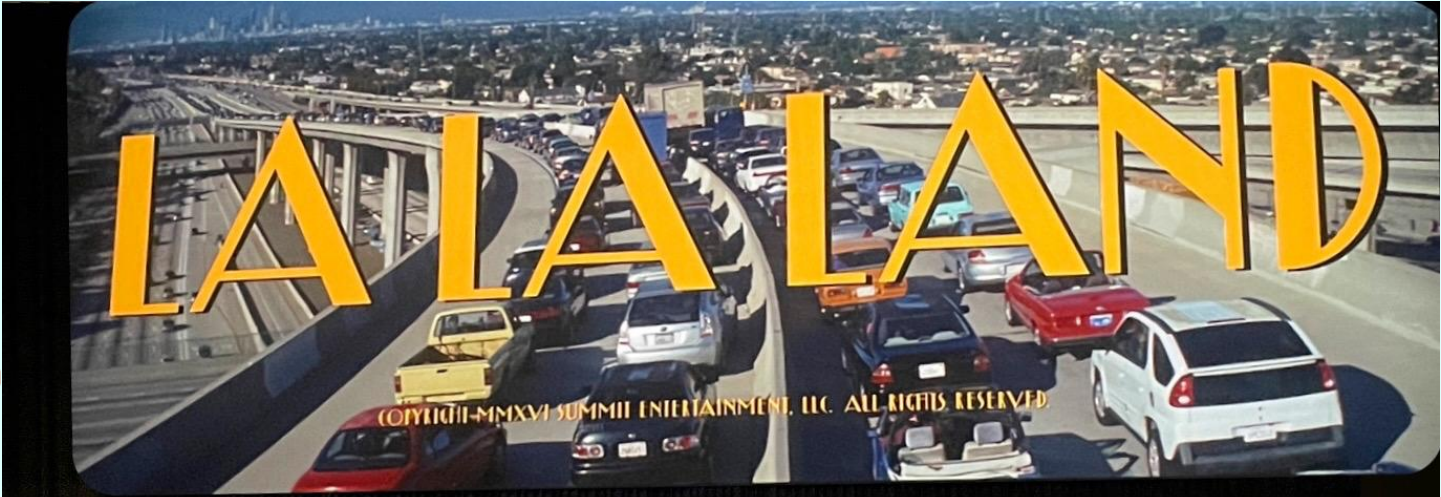

Please see Mrs. Carlson in the theatre office if you have any questions.



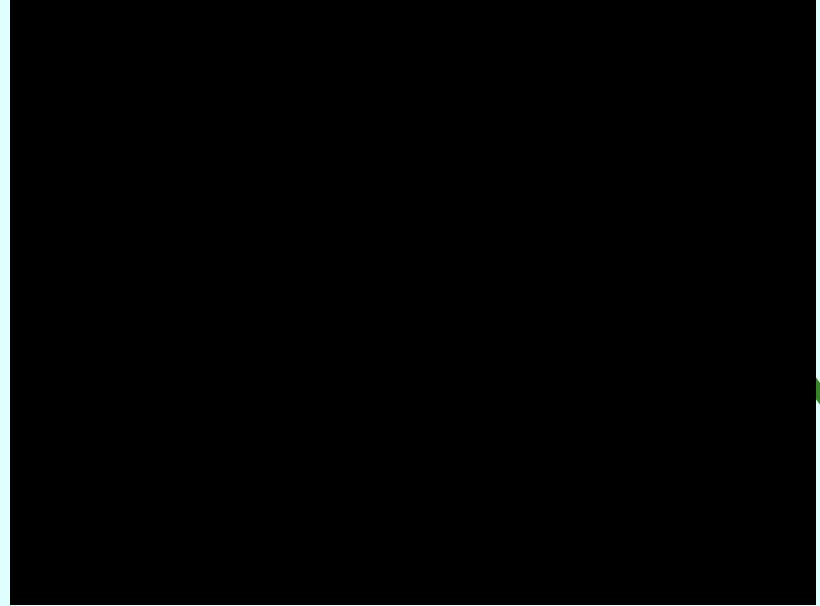

Check your updated Thespian spreadsheet for reference.

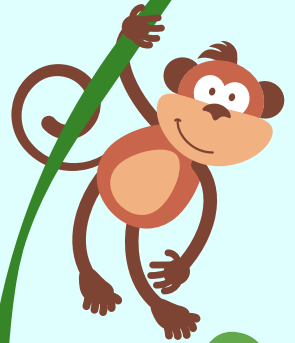

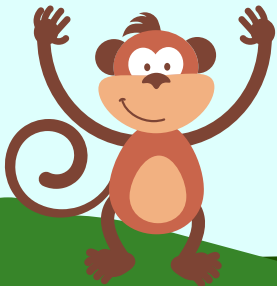

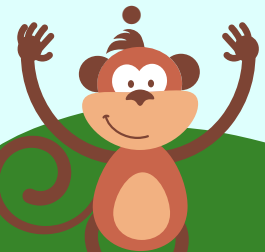
